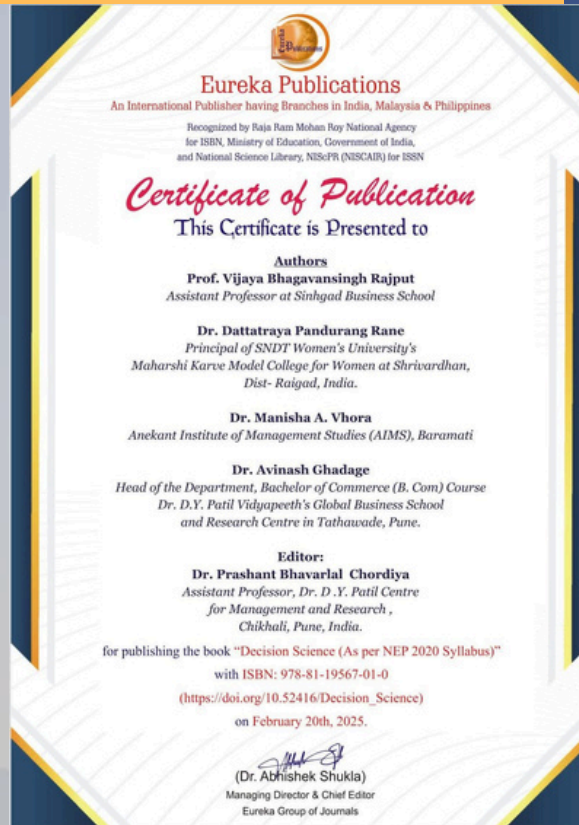


FINANCIAL LITERACY PROGRAM (ONLINE) (20TH DECEMBER 2024)
